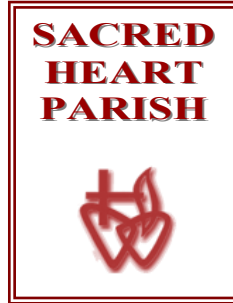

Apple Tart Recipe

8oz Self raising Flour, 4oz Margarine, 1/4 pt water (approx)
4 Lg. Cooking Apples (peeled & cored) Sugar to sweeten.
Method: Preheat oven to 200C Gas 6. Cook apples until soft. Sieve flour into bowl put in margarine and using a knife mix with flour. Add enough water to make a dough. Turn out onto floured board and knead lightly. Roll out half the pastry to meet the size of your greased plate. Arrange apples in centre and then roll remaining pastry to cover the plate. Dampen edge of base pastry with cold water to seal. Cut across the top middle to allow for steam to escape and bake for 35minutes.
